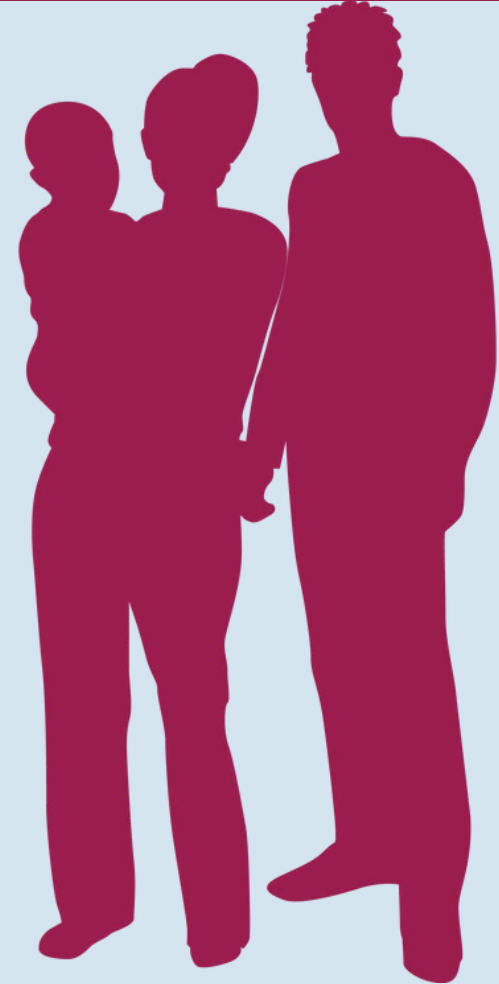

Who we are



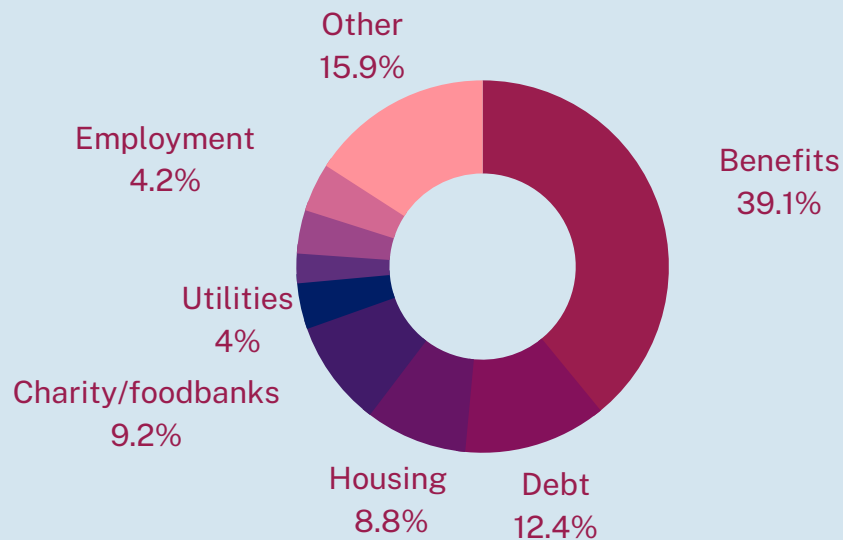
Citizens Advice in West Sussex (North, South, East) is an independent charity and member of the Citizens Advice Network. We provide independent, free and confidential advice to the public on the problems they face. We support over 30,000 people a year on more than 80,000 problems.

We deliver support through our community volunteers (200) ensuring we are placed as a local charity, alongside paid staff (74). We have 6 offices across West Sussex and outreach (15+) advice as well as pop ups. We deliver through all main channels including telephone, email, webchat, in person and increasingly via video.

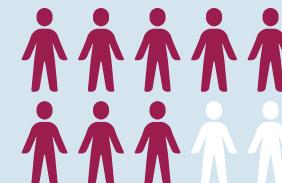

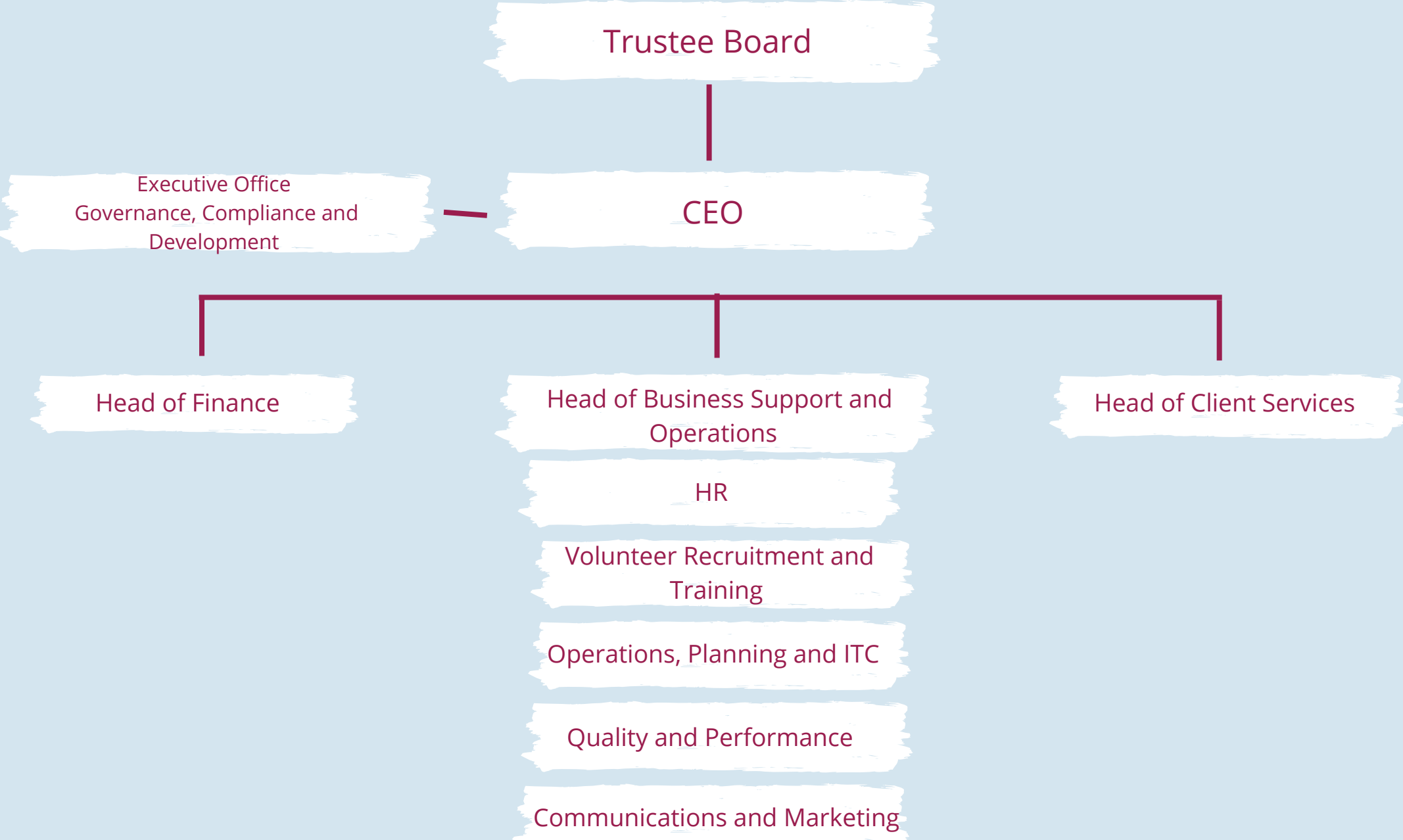
